"CORPORAL" ROCKET:

From a plane which can be towed by a car, to a rocket which needs fifteen trucks - the "Corporal", now in service with the Royal Artillery, and publicly shown here for the first time. Protective clothing must be worn for fuelling the five-ton missile from the acid and aniline tankers. The "Corporal" is a ground-to-ground missile, which can deliver a nuclear warhead on targets over 50 miles away. One Corporal unit therefore has a greater striking power, at greater ranges, than the biggest concentration of artillery ever gathered in World War Two. This powerful weapon alters the whole conception of land warfare.

The "Corporal" is an American missile, and U.S. liaison officers are helping to introduce it into the British Army; but from now on it will be entirely operated by Royal Artillery units, each with its own R.E.M.E. Workshop for specialised testing. The Gunners have used many strange weapons - but none more deadly than this....
