## GERMAN NEWSREEL PRODUCTION

The 30th anniversary of the Nurburg track was celebrated in this year. 66 cars with 2 drivers each participated in the international 1000 kms race. The leading group comprised Maserati-Ferrari-Aston Martini, Porsche and Jaguar.

120,000 fans watched the international aces during the 44 rounds of 22,8 kms each for nearly 8 hours!
