WEDDING IN SALEM

The entire European nobility was represented at the wedding of the year in Salem (Lake Constance). Here in the monastery 29 year-old Prince Tonislav of Jugoslavia, second son of King Alexander - murdered in Marseille in 1934 - was married to Princess Margarita of Baden.

After the orthodox ceremony, celebrated by Bishop Dionisize, the couple was also married in accordance with evangelic rites. The bride wore the traditional Yugoslav crown.

The bridegroom, brother of Exking Peter, operates a modern fruitfarm in Sussex - England.-The young couple is related with practically all European nobility. Most prominent guest was Prince Philip.
