BOMB EXPLOSES IN ALGIERS CASINO Positive developed: 71 meters - 240 ft

Terrerrists made another killing in a particularly ugly expedition when a bemb was hidden in a Casine, Casine Saint Engene in Algiers, and exploded while young people, both curepeans and arabs were denoing and spending a leisuarly evening in the Casine.

Ten people were killed and 80 severely injured, several had to be emputated. Among the victims are the erchestra leader Lucium Semer and a young girl singer of his erchestra.

This picture shows the afternath of this dramatic explosion, the demolished installations and erchestra platform, and hele made by the exploding bomb which was hidden under the stage.
