SCOTTISH INTERNATIONAL CAMP AT BLAIR ATHOLL

In connection with celebrations for the Centenary of our Founder, Lord Baden-Powell, Scotland is holding an International Camp in the grounds of Blair Castle, Blair Atholl, from 13th-22nd July 1957. The number attending the Camp will be approximately 850 comprising 700 Scots from every county in Scotland including Shetland, Orkney, Lewis and Skye, and about 150 visitors from other countries. Countries which have already accepted to send representatives are as listed on the attached sheet.

The Chief Guide, Olave, Lady Baden-Powell, G.B.E., will visit the Camp on Wednesday 17th July which is to be an Open Day for all members of the Movement and we anticipate that there will be anything up to 5,000 visiting Guides and Brownies. There will be a special "Camp Fire" (sing song) for everyone starting at 3 p.m. at which the Chief Guide will speak.

We feel that this international event will be of wide news interest and we would therefore be glad to hear from you whether British Pathe Ltd. would be interested in filming the Camp Fire for their News Reel.
