## NOWHERE TO GO.

At Cherteey, in Surrey, there's a caravan site where
200 femilies live. Nost of the men are essential workers at places
like Lendon Airport or Vickers-Armstrong. Mr. Richard Menn, who owns
the site, had plans to make it a model caravan estate - but now these
200 families are faced with eviction. The Ministry, the County Council,
and Cherteey Council have refused to allow them to stay - even they
all own their caravans. For this is part of London's Green Belt.
Right next door is a licensed caravan site; but the County Council
decides it is time to call a halt. Our interviewer calls on Mrs.
Stanley, wife of a hospital technicum, to discuss the problem.

And the answer? An annonymous Council employee gave it in three words! "Nore flippin' 'ouses!".
