At Assuen in Egypt, Prince Kerin - the new Aga Khan arrives with the Begum for the funeral of his grandfather, Bewteen the Nile and the desert is the family villa where the late Aga's body will rest until a permenent nausoleum is finished.

Also with Karin are his father, Aly Khan, and his Unole, Sadmiddin. According to Moslem custom, the mourners remove their shoes before entering for the funeral rites. The 45-minute service is a comperatively small one - but the thoughts of 20 million Ismaili Moslems are with the family as the spiritual leader! of this worldwide community is laid to rest.

Clothed in white, the Begum Aga Khan sits by her husband's coffin. The French-born Begun, for so many years the gracious consort of a wise and much-loved leader, is deeply distressed. But in the pears to come she will be a valued counsellor to his successor. last, the Aga proved his freshness of mind, by cheesing to succed him a 20-year-old undergraduate reared in the epoch whose problems he must face.
