## Ohruschschow in Berlin

The Soviet Party Chief Nikita Ohruschschow arrived in East Berlin at the head of a delegation which included Deputy Ministerpresodent Mikojan and Foreign Minister Gromyko.

They were greeted by the East German Party Chief Ulbricht and the prominent members of the East German communist government and party delegations.

The Soviet leader inspected a guard of honour of the Volks Army of the so-called DDR (German Democratic Republic) and was then welcomed by Ulbricht.

The guests were then accompanied to Berlin-Pankow - the seat of the East German government.

On the next day the Soviet delegation went to the Soviet Memorial in Berlin-~~Leptow~~ and placed wreaths in memory of the Russian soldiers who died in the war. East German soldiers participate in the ceremony.

The memorial is made of the marble and bronze material of the Hitler Reichchancellery.

The visit is scheduled to last a week.
