Chruschtschow in Berlin

The Eriet Party Chief Hikita Chruschtscher arrived in East Derlin at the head of a delegation which included Deputy Ministerpresedent Mikojan and Fereugn Minister Gromyke. They were greeted by the East German Party Chief Ulbricht and the prominent members of the East German communist government and party delegations.

The Soviet leader inspected a guard of honour of the Volks Army of the socalled DDR (German Democratic Republic) and was then welcomed by Ulbricht.

The guests were then accompanied to Berlin-Pankow - the seat of the East German government.

On the next day the Soviet delegation went to the Soviet Memorial in Berlin Reptow and placed wreaths in memory of the Russian soldiers who died in the war. East German soldiers participate in the ceremony.

The memorial is made of the marble and bronze material of the Hitler Reichchancellory.
