A new speleologic expedition has been organized in the Central Pyrenees by the speleologic-group of Provence and the scouts of Aix en Provence, who have joined their efforts to those of the famous specialist Norbert Casteret and his daughter, in order to disclose the mystery of the Pierre Cave, situated at Côme Quarnde. This cave, situated at an height of 1490 m. is the highest cave of the Massif de la Côme.

In this place are situated the sources of other caves where the temperature is so low as to find ice at a depth of 48 meters.

Those speleologues do not consider their descent as a sport event but as a scientific study for they hope with the help of Norbert Casteret and Joseph Delteil to pierce the mystery of the net "Trombe" originating from the Pierre Cave.

Will they be able to prove that the whole mountain is crossed by an underground river which wells out in the Gouil di Her grotto.

This is the aim of this interesting expedition.
