In an eight-inch gap between two buildings at Providence, Rhode Island, three-year-old Eileen Fahy is wedged. For 20 hours no one knew where she was; now she's found - but the only way to save her is to punch a hole in the twelve-inch breeze-blocks. Little Eileen was chasing a kitten when she got stuck between the walls - and now a nation holds its breath while rescuers ship away as fast they dare, towards the imprisoned child. She's alive and whimpering, but weak with exposure and shock.

A single false move could do serious harm - but inch by inch the wall breaks away, exposing the limp body and the small blonde head. After 90 minutes of suspense, the job is done - and with a sigh of relief the rescuers hurry Eileen to the waiting ambulance.

She's alive and not seriously harmed - but more than 20 hours in this narrow gap, not knowing when help could come, is something no adult would care to face - let alone a three-year-old child!
