At Collonge, near Geneva, the Aga Khan's family gather; Aly Khan's fiancée, Bettina, in a dress of opal silk is early on the scene. The occasion - the wedding of Sadruddin, Aly Khan's brother, who arrives with his mother Princess Andree.

Behind the bridegroom is the 20-year-old Aga Khan, Prince Karim, with his father, Aly Khan, and his brother Amin, the youngest man of the family.

And now, at last, the bride - Nina Dyer, Kensington-born model. She's ten minutes late, which only adds to the photographers impatience - but there's a bodyguard to take care of such things.

Twenty-four-year-old Sadruddin - Sadri for short - is one of the world's richest men. At the moment, he's the only married man in this fabulous family - and the young Aga Khan himself strongly denies rumours that he's even thinking of getting engaged. Sadri and Nina - the the pale grey organdie dress Dior designed for her - leave for the Moslem wedding and the reception at Chateau Bellerive, the family mansion on the shores of Lake Geneva.

The name Sadruddin means "Chief of the Faith", Now Nina has a Moslem name, too - Shirin, which means "Sweetness".
