MOTORCYCLE GRAND PRIX.

It's the Grand Prix des Nations at Monza - Britain's Geoff Duke holds the 500 c.c. record, but there are plenty out to capture it from him - for this is the last motorcycle classic to count towards the 1957 world championship, and there are more than 80,000 fans here to see who will carry off the title.

Well up among the leaders is young John Surtees of Britain, riding an M.V. Augusta - but just ahead is Libero Liberati on a Gilera.

Liberati breaks Geoff Duke's record for the course by averaging more than 115 miles an hour - and he crosses the line 50 seconds ahead of Duke's Gilera, to capture his first world championship!
