## KING FOR FIVE YEARS:

Ruler of Maleya. The Duke of Gloucester represents the Queen at this solemn ceremony - first of its kind in the newly-independent Maleya state. Before the assembled Saltans, the Grand Chamberlain, reads the preclamation which names Sir Abdul as "yang di-Pertuan Agong" - he-who-is-made-lord. Ready for handing over is the Kris Panjeng - the sward of state. It will be the symbol of Sir Abdul's authority for the next five years - for under the new federal constitution, the head of each Maleyan state, in rotation, will hold the title of Paramount Ruler for a five-year-term.

Once the cath has been taken, Tang di-Pertuan Agong is efficially in power. The coremony is over, and the ruler and his consort leave the hall. A heavy responsibility rests on his shoulders - to lead the twelfth number of the Commonwealth through the first difficult years of self-government.
