

PRESIDENT COTY ENTERTAINS:

President Eisenhower arrives at the Elysee Palace, where President Coty welcomes him and Mr. Dulles to a State Dinner. Prime Minister of Luxembourg, Mr. Beck is here too; also Marshal Juin, and Germany's Herr Von Brentano. From Britain, Mr. Harold Macmillan. Only woman present is Mrs. Egloff, President Coty's daughter. The occasion - the end of the NATO heads-of-state conference.
