STORY : INDIA'S VICE PRESIDENT HOLDS RECEPTION
IN HONOUR OF MR & MRS. MACMILLAN.

Plus X. EXTERIORS IN GOOD DAY LIGHT

Compared with other days, the fourth day of Mr & Mrs. Macmillan's stay in New Delhi, the capital of India, was quiet. The only engagement of Public importance was a very colourful reception held by the Vice President of India. The Moghul Gardens of the President's House in New Delhi presented a charming atmosphere to which the glamour was added by the presence of colourful lancers of the President's Body Guard. A very selected gentry of more than one than guests from all important shores of life were invited to meet the Macmillans. There were high government officials, there were important diplomats and there were other prominent people from the capital.

Accompanied by the Vice President and followed by Mr. Nehru, Mr & Mrs. Macmillan arrived at the Moghul Gardens. Soon after the President of India Dr. Rak RAJENDRA PRASAD escorted by aides and body guards arrived and was received by the Vice President and Mr & Mrs. Macmillan. The Macmillans mixed with general crowd and later they were sitting with the President. While the President was talking with Mr. Macmillan, Lady Macmillan was having a word with a lady from the Japanese Embassy in New Delhi.

Shot of Secretariat building framed through Indian Flag and The Union Jack.

With several Indian and British flags in the frame shot of the Parliament House in New Delhi. All sorts of traffic is on the move.
