

WALES ONLY:58/11.WALES - v - SCOTLAND:(RUGBY)

Wales, in the lighter shirts, kick off against Scotland at Cardiff Arms Park - and they're full of confidence, because it's 21 years since a Scotland fifteen defeated Wales on Welsh soil. The Scottish three-quarters efforts are repeatedly smothered by their Welsh opposite numbers - and the crowd see some brilliant play by Lloyd Williams at scrum half and Cliff Morgan at stand-off, who get the ball neatly away from the scrum time and time again.

Left winger G. Wells is baulked by A.R. Smith, and the ball's in touch.

Wales get the ball again - but once more it's a tussle between Wells and Smith. They're racing for the corner flag - Wells gets there first - and it's a try!

G. Davies takes the kick - and converts magnificently!

Second half, and the Welsh three-quarters are on the attack again. The ball's passed to M.C. Thomas, who tries to bulldoze through - but Weatherstone brings him down.

A.R. Smith, the Scottish captain, takes a penalty kick from 40 yards out - and scores!
