BERNARD BUFFET'S ART Positive developed: 74 meters - 247 ft

Bernerd BUFFET is under 50 and already a very famous painter who caused a consation, when he arganized a show of his work since his beginings twelve years ago, a kind of retreepective where the evolution of his art can be studied.

He caused such a sensation that an estimated 5,000 people waited for one hour before the opening of the doors of the austers Charpentiar Hall where the show is, and as soon as the doors were epened it was a rush inside of all celebrities of Paris society.

Bernard Buffet a handsome young man was accompanied by post and academician Jean COCTEAU, and immediately surrounded by his friends and admireus, among whom were Jacques Villon, 84, and the aldest living painter, and Mr.Bordeneuve former Secretary of State for Arts.

Bernard Buffet was first known in 1956, but at the time his paintings were sold 500 grance each, then suddenly they rose to 5 to 60co frances and now the smallest of his pictures is worth a million. He made the backgrounds of Francoise Segan's ballet which was given for the first time in Monte Carlo a few weeks ago.
