ICE TROTTEING.

Trotting's an exciting sport in many parts of the world - but trotting on ice instead of cinder track is even more exciting. At the Austrian holiday resort of Zell-am-See thousands turn out to watch trotting events on the frozen lake - and fresh snow on the 2,000-yard course makes ideal conditions for some really fast racing. This is the Dr. Porsche Memorial Race - an event which attracts drivers from miles around.
