AMMUNITION TRAIN BLOWS UP.

At least 50 people died, and 26 were seriously injured, when this ammunition train blew up during unloading in a military siding at Pathankote, a big Indian Army base 350 miles north of Delhi near the foothills of Kashmir. Hovering round the twisted wreckage are vultures a grim reminder that more bodies may still be buried underneath. An Army squad marks out the danger area - for there is still more live ammunition scattered about and the heat of the explosion has not yet dispersed. So great was the force of the blast that wreckage and pieces of clothing were flung many hundreds of yards. From such complete devastation, the cause of the disaster may never be learned.
