Description of cut subject : "OPENING OF X-RAY CAMPAIGN IN EDINBURGH"

Scenes at Bandstand while awaiting arrival of torch bearers who have run from Aberdeen in relays bearing the X-Ray torch.

The waiting crowd are entertained by Highland dancers and Band of The Black Watch.

After the campaign had been opened by Rt. Hon. J. S. Maclay, Secretary of State for Scotland the torch bearers arrive and are received by the Lord Provost of Edinburgh, who hands the torch to an Edinburgh athlete, who leads the procession to a Big Top erected in Princes St. gardens.

A tape is then cut by an 8 year old boy and girl.

Inside the tent Secretary of State and Lord Provost register and are X-Rayed. First the Lord Provost who is seen being unrobed, followed by Sec. of State.
