## DMORTAL BRIDGE:

Seven conturies is a long time for a bridge to stand and when it's lasted that long, it's worth a bit of trouble to keep it standing. St. Trinita, over the Armo, is the most famous bridge in Florence; Masi units blow it up in 1944, but the Florentines have rebuilt it exactly as it was.

The bridge is re-spend in the presence of Prime Minister Zeli. St. Trimita bridge was first built by Dominican Priers in 1269, and when floods swept it away nearly 300 years later, Michelangele took part in its rebuilding. It withstood the floods for another 387 years - and it took the Maxis to think of deliberately destroying it. Architect Chischulich was responsible for the restaration. It cost £170,000 - but the people of Florence are proud of their immortal bridge, and they contributed a fifth of the money themselves.
