

**INTERNATIONAL MOTO-CROSS COMPETITION**  
**Positive developed; 20 meters - 85 ft**

The Motorcycle Club of the Vienne Department has organized an international motorcycle competition in Poitiers, on the rough and accidented track of the Chardenchamps stone quarry.

In the 500 Cc.class fought in two parts each of 12 laps and a third winning one in 15 laps, two of the best international aces of this speciality were on the starting line, British, Belgian, Dutch, and French champions.

The first part of the competition was won by the belgian K. ROMBATS (Nr.2) who had the second place in last year's Championship of Belgian. second was the Englishman L.ARCHER (Nr.1).

Second part saw the victory of L.ARCHER(nr.1) on Norton while the third and last part of the competition was won by the Dutchman B.DIRKX on BSA, with L.ARCHER right in his back wheel.

In the overall classification victory went to the British ace L.ARCHER, together with the trophy for this difficult and daring competition.
