Many holy men, or Sadhus, come to Kurukshetra for the ceremonies of the colipse. Nehang Singh is a Warrior Sadhu armed to the teeth - and to the top of his huge turban. A sadhu's hair may be as much as ten feet long, for he never cuts it - and he washes it only once a year, or on special occasions like this.

But he takes the utmost care with his make-up, for the sandely wood paste markings on his face indicate the sect to which he belongs and they have to be just so!
