British Honduras is the last land to act as host to Princess Margaret in her unforgettable tour of the Caribbean - surely one of the gayest Royal tours of the century. A parade of fraternal societies, including political parties of every colour, is held at Newtown Barracks in Belize, the capital. British Honduras, includes many different national communities, each with its own culture and traditions - and, of course, its own dances. This is a "Hoese" dance, performed by East Indians.

And now "John Canoe", a native dance by Caribs from Stann Creek, down the coast from Belize.

At night, a State dinner is held at Government House - but the Caribbean people have said their real farewell in their own way - with music and dancing.
