CZECH RIDERS EXPECTED FOR BERKSHIRE

INTERNATIONAL SCRAMBLE

Jaromir Cizek and Ron Frantisek, the Czech motor-cycle

scramble aces, are likely to race at Beenham Park, near Reading, on Sunday, in the International Coupe d'Europe.

With their entry there is bound to be a tremendous battle developing between them and the German riders, one of whom is Fritz Betzlbacher the present European champion. The British, headed by Brian Stonebridge on his Greeves machine, are also powerful contenders.

The winner of this event for 250 c.c. machines will be awarded the Daily Herald Challenge Trophy as well as adding eight points to his score in the European championship table. The meeting is one of 12 in the 1958 series. Cizek has already shot well away in the three meetings already held, winning the Swiss and French events and coming second in the Austrian.

Both Czech aces ride Jawa machines, made by one of the best known manufacturers of small motor-cycles in Europe.
