PROGRAMME FOR VISIT OF H.R.H. THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH
TO PANMURE HOUSE

July 1, 1958

At 6.30 p.m. H.R.H. leaves the Palace of Holyroodhouse proceeding by Calton Road, and arriving at Panmure House at about 6.35 p.m., entering by the Scotsman Garage entrance. H.R.H. is met by the Hon. President of the Canongate Boys' Club (The Duke of Hamilton) who presents the Warden (Dr. Ronald Selby Wright).

On the upper courtyard the Warden presents the Sub. Warden (Mr. H.W. Richmond) who will have returned the day before from visiting Youth Centres in the U.S.A. on the English Speaking Union Scholarship, the Assistant Minister (Mr. R. Buchanan-Smith), and certain Club Leaders.

The Warden presents Mr. Roy Thomson who restored Panmure House and gave it to the Boys' Club, and who will be accompanied by Sir Edward Stevenson, and Mr. Cochran the Foreman Builder.

H.R.H. enters the Club and in the Princess Royal Hall meets the boys who are taking part in the Duke of Edinburgh Award. The Warden presents the Head Boy (Mr. Stuart Macfarlane), and the Head of the Gytes (the Junior Boys - Mr. Alastair Black), who will conduct H.R.H. from then onwards round the Club.

H.R.H. unveils the War Memorial, which is then dedicated, and signs the portrait to hang in the Hall.

H.R.H. is then presented with the specially bound volume of the history of the Club by the ex-Head Boy (Mr. Pringle Fisher) and, accompanied by the boys, leaves the Club by way of the Canongate at about 6.55 p.m.
