In the woods near Doorn, there's a new veterans' centre which has been specially designed to enable them to rely on themselves - even to garage doors which they can unlock without climbing out of their cars! The wounded veteran is no longer an object of charity; he is recognised as a citizen who deserves a chance to lead a useful life - and, as far as possible, a normal one.

To declare the centre officially open comes Queen Juliana of the Netherlands herself.

Even sport is not forgotten - and the ex-servicemen, all of whom are victims of spinal injury, entertain Queen Juliana with a lively game of basketball.

At this centre, built by contributions from ordinary people all over Holland, disabled veterans can live and work in contentment and self-respect.
