Dawn Fraser establish new world-record on 100 m. free stroke .

In Schiedam the Dutch national swimming-championships were held with the participation of the Australian swim-phenomenons.

On the 100 m. free stroke a new world-record was established by Dawn Fraser. Immediately after the start the Australian girl took the lead.

Behind her a big struggle occurred between Australian Lorraine Crapp and Dutch Geekie Gastelaars.

Dawn Fraser finished in 1 minute 1,2 seconds, which meant she has broken her own record at the Empire Games in Cardiff of 1 minute 1,4 seconds.

The national title was gained by Geekie Gastelaars in 1 minute 4 seconds.
