<u>Return journey</u> - A rendezvous will be arranged by the drivers. The coaches are timed to leave for London at 7 p.m. and we should be grateful if you would report to the rendezvous by that time.

H.R.H. PRINCESS MARGARET -

Princess Margaret will arrive just before 4 p.m., inspect the Guard of Honour (Members of the Oxfordshire Branch) and walk through all rooms at Blenheim Palace. On taking her seat she will be presented with a bouquet by HILARY COATES, 81; Banbury Road, Kidlington, aged 8 years, a Link member of the Oxfordshire Branch.

She will present MONSIEUR YVES ST. LAURENT with the Society's Badge of Honour, which entitles the recipient to Life Membership of the British Red Cross Society, at approximately 6 p.m. An announcement to this effect will be made by DAME ANNE BRYANS, tho Society's Deputy Chairman, over the loud speaker system which is installed in all rooms.

At the end of the presentation Princess Margaret will retire, but before doing so will walk through all the rooms. At approximately 6.45 p.m. she will draw the tickets for the raffle in the GREAT HALL.

The Hon. Iris Peake will be in attendance.

- ALLA DE DUIMEN Alla is MANCHURIAN. Was very young when she came to France to complete her education. Is THE SENIOR MEMBER OF THE "CABINE". Married to a fashion photographer and has a 2-year old son and looks after him entirely. She loves the country where she spends her week-ends with her husband and child. Is known throughout the world and has modelled in every country.

KOUKA GASPARD

Was born in Buenos Aires. Is 25. Educated in the Argentine, first at the "Lycee" and then studied medicine for a year at the Faculty of Medicine. Was admitted to the "Corps de Ballet" of the Colon Theatre. To be a mannequin was her heart's desire; she longed to go to Paris and went for a fortnight, after winning a prize, and stayed for 2 years. Was engaged by Givenchy's three days after her arrival and was photographed for magazines. HAS HEEN A MEMBER OF THE DIOR "CABINE" FOR A MONTH. She has travelled widely BUT THIS IS HER FIRST VISIT TO ENGLAND. She is "very fond of the theatre, the ballet, but above all she loves her "Maison"." Keen on the classics.

DENISE GIRARD Denise was born in Quebec in 1936 - her parents are French Canadian. Lived there until 14 years of age, when she went to live with an aunt in Monte Carlo to widen her education. Finished in London. In 1954 she went to Paris and met M. Christian DIOR WHO WAS A RELATION. Loves travelling. Sports are tennis, swimming and skiing. Fond of the theatre and music and goes to the country as often as possible.

LUCKY JANICHEWSKY Born in Quimper. MARRIED at 16 and has a daughter of 14. BEGAN her modelling career at Hermes. Then she went to Fath. Has been with Dior 8 years. Loves the country and has a little cottage near Chartres. She directs the "Mutuelle des Mannequins", which she created 5 years ago, and also the mannequin school where she teaches every evening.

SVETIANA KASSESSINOF Svetlana is a Russian. She was born in Cairo in 1934. Her father is a painter of miniatures. Studied in Egypt till she was 14. Mother wanted her to be a ballerina and sent her to London to study. At 19 she entered the SADDLER'S WELLS BALLET. Went for a 6-month tour with the Old Vic Theatre in the U.S.A., but unfortunately she broke her left leg and had to rest for six months. Afterwards was given a part in "The King and I". Two years ago she went to Paris. She happened to pass the Dior Salon and decided to go in. Christian Dior saw her and immediately engaged her. Svetlana speaks 5 languages. Still studies ballet. Not keen on sports but does some fencing. VERY KEEN ON COOKING - VERY SUPERSTITIOUS - her colour is RED.

LIVIA LAMBLIN

Aged 26 - born in London where she was educated. Went to Paris 5 years ago to study French at the Sorbonne. Had four years with Balenciaga. Thinks of Paris as her second home loves to roam there looking for bits of furniture for her flat. Has travelled extensively and is very fond of ballet.
