Dear Miss Field,

re: The Trans-Atlantic Balloon Flight

This is to confirm the verbal discussions you have had with the Daily Mail Syndication Department regarding the showing of film dealing with the above Expedition through the medium of your newreel service.

You are entitled to film the car and two members of the Expedition and also to record brief interviews with the two members of the Expedition and, subject to the following provisos :-

- 1) The film material as shown in the newreel is not to exceed 5 minutes duration and is not to be screened outside the United Kingdom and Eire.
- 2) Recorded interviews with the members of the Expedition are not to include any information which has not yet been published in the Daily Mail.
- 3) The Daily Mail Syndication Department has the right to view the newreel film material affecting the Expedition prior to its release.
- 4) The verbal commentary introducing the film material is to give an appropriate credit to the Daily Mail.
- 5) Only authorised camera crew and technicians are to accompany the newreel unit when taking the film.
- 6) No still films dealing with the Expedition are to be published, issued or distributed in any way.
- 7) The above facilities do not include any other rights whatsoever in the Expedition and no film shot is to be transmitted by television in any circumstances.

Please confirm in writing that you accept the provisions of this letter.
