AFRICANS DEMAND LIBERATION:

200 delegates to the All African Peoples Conference heard a speech much to their liking by the Prime Minister of Chana, Dr. Kwame Mkrumah. He told them to aim at a United States of Africa, to be formed on the model of the U.S.A. A small beginning was already made by the union of Chana and Guinea.

A subsequent speaker put it more crudely, saying: "SCRAM OUT OF AFRICA". One of their alogams used the historic Communist cry, "WE HAVE NOTHING TO LOSE BUT OUR CHAINS". Propaganda made use of modern techniques.

The coloured delegates came from twenty-five countries.

African and Asian. The Kremlin sent seven Russians among the observers.

Africans criticised some of their own institutions, "Down with

Tribalism" being one of the alogams. Delegates from Kenya demanded

the release of a Mau Mau leader, Jomo Kenyatta. A lighter noise was

struck by the Senegalese delegate, in what the well dressed tribesman

should wear. Quite a thought provoking conference.
