The RAI-building in Amsterdam is transformed for ~~ten~~ ten days into an dorado for the women.

A fully automatic cooking-range of 2500 guilders with an impressive button-system is one of the novelties on this household-fair.

Who presses the wrong button can be faced with odd surprises.

The ice-box is used in more and more Dutch families. This is a complete new type with rotating racks, by which is made the most of space, to put things away.

For those who are cramped for space there is a wall-icebox (with a capacity of 126 litres) which does not take away the dresser of the floor-surface.

The dream-kitchen for each woman also is to be seen at this fair.

There are numerous novelties on the householding-domain and so that everything takes not more than a minimum of space.

A handy help for washing is a wringer, which is fastened at the wall with suckers. It not even weighs three pounds and is a Belgian invention, costing about 28 guilders.

A new kind of tin-opener is shown. Costs, with cover-magnete: about 11 guilders.

Peeling potatoes has not to be a problem anymore in 1959. Moreover the apparatus makes beets and roots ready to be cooked, without the use of a kitchen-knife.

And finally still this:

Solution, a plastic coat-hanger for one guilder only!

A very nice, but expensive demonstration, for so to see it was a well-useable jacket.
