NATO ON PARADE.

5,000 Allied servicemen paraded in Mains to mark
the 10th Anniversary of the North Atlantic Alliance. Outstanding
feature was the appearance of Germans in the parade. NATO G-in-C.,
General Nerstad, and his fellow commanders inspected the units,
which were contributed by most of the fifteen member-nations of
the Alliance. German paratreeps were preminent in the march past
the saluting base.

On the rostrum with the generals was German Federal Minister Von Markats. Next in the march came the Americans.

General Valley saw his countrymen in a typical French display.

No contingents looked smarter than the British, part of our contribution to the Alliance which has for ten years preserved peace.
