A. By Train.

(1) Ex London

Depart Euston 8.20 a.m.

Arrive Stafford 11.04 a.m.

(11) Ex Stafford

Depart Stafford 5.41 p.m.

Arrive Euston 8.33 p.m.

Transport will be arranged to and from
Stafford and Lilleshall.

B. By Road

Lilleshall is approximately three miles
from Newport which is 142 miles from London,
16 miles from Stafford, 17 miles from
Wolverhampton and 11 miles from Shrewsbury.
The best route is straight up the A5 turning
off right after passing through Weston-under-
Lizard on to the B5314. When you come to
a signpost to Donnington, cross the main road
A41 and continue to the end of the T junction.
Turn left and almost immediately right to
a signpost marked Lilleshall Hall. 300 yards
down the hill to a lodge on the right which
marks the entrance to the drive.
