

U. S. ATOM SUB AT NORTH POLE.

The United States submarine "Skate" submerged soon after leaving its American base bound for the North Pole. The nuclear powered vessel had been there before, but this time she planned to break surface exactly at the Pole. On a special monitor screen the periscope was shown above the ice.

And here's a polar bear's eye view of the spectacular surfacing, exactly at the Pole, at the top of the world, in the midst of an ice-covered sea.

Only fifty years ago the Pole was discovered by the American Commander Peary. To fly there has been possible for some years, but Skate is the first submarine to see the Polar light of day. Here, undetected, she could launch a missile and slip quietly back into the deep.
