CARDINAL CUSHING GETS FREEDOM.

Outside the Church of Our Lady of Lourdes, in Drogheda, Cardinal Cushing inspected a guard of honour mounted by the South Louth Battalion, F.C.A. His Eminence, who is Archbishop of Boston, came to hear the scroll of Freedom read by the Town Clerk, Johnsten, after which he graciously received it from the hands of Mayer Hughes. The Very Reverend Monsignor Stokes was in attendance. It now remained for Cardinal Cushing to add his name to the role of free men.
