



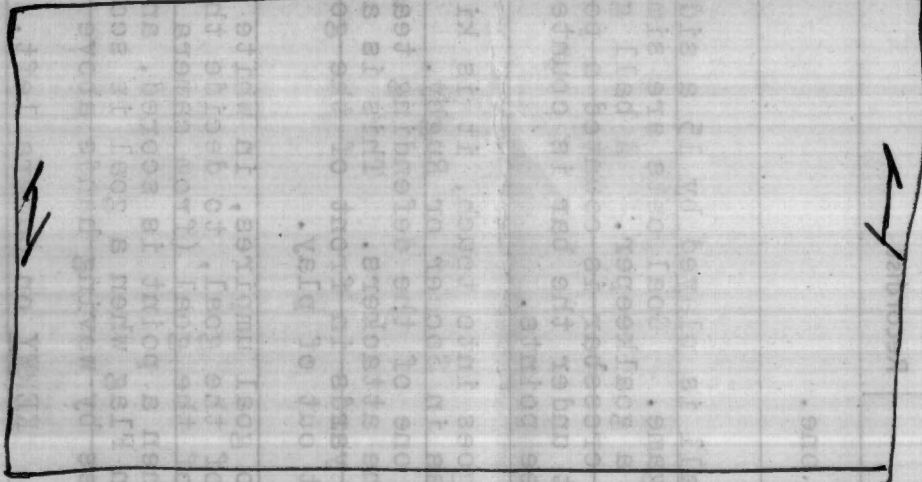

WHO ELSE COVERED No one. Say if sound or silent		
LIST OF SHOTS Note: Gaelic Football is played by 15 a side, and is a handling and kicking game. Goalposts are similar to rugby posts, but there is a goalkeeper. A ball going between the posts but over the crossbar is counted a point, a ball between the posts but under the bar is counted a goal. A goal is equal to three points.		
When a ball goes into touch, it is kicked into play again, not thrown, as in Soccer or Rugby. When it goes over the end line off one of the defending team, a "Fifty" is awarded to the attackers. This is a free kick taken from a line fifty yards in front of the goal and opposite where the ball went out of play.		
There are two goal umpires, in white coats standing on either side of the goal, to decide the scores. The one to the left of the goal (from camera position) waves a White Flag when a point is scored, and the one on the right waves a Green Flag when a goal is scored. They also indicate wides by waving hands above head.		
Shot 1. Roll 1. <u>KERRY</u> on Camera left.		
Crowd shots. General View of Ground during parade of teams before start of match. Throw-in to start match. P. Smith of Derry kicks ball and following play.
