- FASHION: & Baby of the show, Akiko, in "Blue Mood" ... a high-waisted kimono for western living.
- FASHION: And this is Kiku Festival a two-piece suit in cotton.

 The colours are carpot and onion white, and the lantern hat was designed by Madame Sakai herself.
- FASHION: (*) Here's a beach style ... with the jacket printed in symbolic designs of the Japanese theatre.
- FASHION: And for high fashion, a pure silk organza dress with a theatre coat of gold lame and carrot silk. A gown to attract attention in ANY setting.
- THREE GIRLS: Japanese mannequins show how traditional eastern cloths can be used in western style.
