

HELICOPTER AIDS LIGHTHOUSE.

Just off Ouessant Island, Brittany, a lighthouse wrecked by the Nazis nearly twenty years ago is coming back into service. Till 1940 it stood sentinel at the gale-torn north-west tip of France. Thanks to a helicopter, which can make a pinpoint landing, the lighthouse is at last being repaired. Up to now, no one was able to get the men and materials on to the site. Obviously even without a helicopter it would not have been completely impossible, or the lighthouse could never have been built at all; nevertheless the job hung fire all these years. Now, even a disabled workman can get to the place. With three others he's taken to and from the job every day, and in addition the whirlibird has flown out five tons of cement and various repair materials.

Thanks to this helicopter idea the light put out by the Nazis will soon shine again...
