STREA PALIC

The old traditional Siena Palie race takes place twice in a years at July beginning (2nd) and middle August (16th) with the participation of the "Centrade" a sort of a districts of the town.

Back in the centuries each Centrada with its own church was a little state within the State; they are 17, most named after animals' names: Istrice, Lupe, Bruce, Brage, Giraffa, Oca, Givetta, Pantera, Montene, Tartuca, Chioccicla, Aquila, Nicchio, Lecuerno, Selva, Torce, Onda.

Representatives of each Centrada, upon a parade along the main street of Siena, meet in Piazza del Campe to fight for the Palie award.

Thousands of tourists flock in , so the place is overcrowded; even tops of buildings are hired to watch the fight. Being it an historical celebration, the event is held with the ancient traditional gymment colorful costumes.

This year's second tournament has been won by the Contrada "Oca" ("Goose")
