ELECTRONIC GUN SCORES BULL'S-EYE!

Police in hot pursuit of a getaway car! But it's only to demonstrate a new weapon invented by electrician C. A. Stockholm - an electronic gun fired from within the police car.

Inventor Stockholm dismantles the gun to show the 21-shot cartridge chamber and firing mechanism located on the hood. The gun solves an officer's problem of how to drive his car at high speed while firing at the same time. In this case, all he has to do is aim the car itself at the target and pull the trigger. Stockholm gets in to show how it's done.

There's the chase again, conducted at de-activated Hondo Airbase, Texas. The trigger activates the mechanism on the hood electrically, while a special instrument tells the driver if his aim is right. He can fire accurately at 120 miles an hour!
