Dear Sir,

I am writing further to our telephone conversation today from which I was glad to learn that it will be possible for you to arrange for a representative to join the press flight to Glasgow on September 2 for the preview of the Scottish Industries Exhibition.

The flight arrangements are as follows:- Depart London West Air Terminal 7 a.m. where a special bus will be waiting to take the party to London Airport. Depart London Airport 8 a.m., arriving Renfrew Airport 9.35 a.m. The flight number is BE 890.

The timings for the return journey from Glasgow to London on the same day on flight BE 907 are as follows:- Depart Renfrew Airport 5.30 p.m., arriving London Airport 7 p.m. There will, of course, be a special bus waiting in Glasgow to take the party to Renfrew.
