Thursday August 27

President arrives at London Airport (North) Met by Lord in Waiting (Lord Gosford), Prime Minister and Foreign Secretary. Inspects Guard of Honour. Brief statements by Prime Minister and President.

6.45.p.m.

Press enclosure with camera stands on grass verge (west). (Plan attached.) Admission to press enclosure open to holders of press passes for the visit. The camera stand will accommodate up to 24 tripod cameras and 25 hand cameras. The front of the press enclosure will also be available to hand cameras. Positions for tripod cameras will be balloted for. (Applications to P.R.O. London Airport not later than noon on August 26.)

Drive in open motor car to U.S. Ambassador's residence accompanied by the Prime Minister.

7.00.p.m.

Car No. 3 in the President's procession has been allocated to News Agencies. (1 reporter each.)

Arrive at United States Ambassador's residence.

8.00.p.m.

A photographic rota facility outside the door of Winfield House on the President's arrival, and for reporters from the News Agency car.

Private dinner with U.S. Ambassador.

8.30.p.m.

Friday August 28

Leave U.S. Ambassador's residence accompanied by the Prime Minister.

7.50.a.m.

News agencies car to follow the President.

Take off from London Airport (North). Seen off by Lord-in-Waiting (Lord Gosford) and by the Prime Minister. Accompanied by Sir E. Fielden, Commander of the Queen's Flight.

8.40.a.m.

Press enclosure at the airport. Admission open to all accredited correspondents.

Arrival at entrance to Balmoral Castle. The President, accompanied by The Duke of Edinburgh, will inspect the Queen's Guard (Royal Highland Fusiliers).

12 noon.

London Air Terminal, Grosvenor Road (British correspondents) at 6.25.a.m.

Take off from London Airport at 7.40.a.m.

Arrive Dyce Airport at 9.35.a.m.

Press enclosure open to all accredited press representatives. Passes for this enclosure are also available from the Scottish Office, St. Andrew's House, Edinburgh (Mr. D.F. Mackenzie).

News agencies car.

Busses will transport the passengers from the press aircraft to Balmoral to be in position for the President's arrival.

Public event. Press enclosure provided for accredited correspondents.

12.30 p.m. Passengers on the press aircraft will leave from Balmoral in busses on the return journey to Dyce.

1.45.p.m. Approximately Take-off. Luncheon on the plane.

A reporters rota facility at Chequers has been arranged for this (Friday) afternoon. Bus for nominated correspondents leaves from 10 Carlton House Terrace at 2.p.m., arriving back at about 5.30.p.m.
