KARIBA ON SCHEDULE.

The Central African Federation is very rightly proud of the progress at Kariba. Despite winter-fleed setbacks almost disasters in fact - the engineers and their army of workmen have caught up the time lest. The pylons on both north and south sides are already in place. They'll carry the power-lines over the gerge. Other men are busy with the read and feetpath over the top of the dam. Telephone instructions from the other side okayed the winshing of a wire over the pylons. That done, they would attach a cable to the wire, and that would be another stage towards transmitting power, Acress the gerge also comes concrete - thousands of tens of it - for read building.

Above the dam, impounded water is forming a man-made lake of 2,000 square miles. All the Commonwealth hails a great achievement, the Kariba Dam.
