The one and only Foxhunter has made his last jump.

His famous partnership with Colonel Harry Llewellyn is ended.

The great-hearted horse died, at 19, at the Colonel's home near Abergavenny. Stemina, courage, style, these were qualities which made Foxhunter unique.

In 1952, Feshunter was flown to Helsinki, to jump at the Olmpic Genes. He was at the peak of his shew-jumping ability; and that bare statement, applied to Feshunter, is the highest possible praise. And there in Pinland, Llewllyn in the saddle, he was superb and supreme. On that occasion they won Britain's only Gold Medal. In the hearts of millions whom he interested in Show Jumping the memory of Fexhunter is ensured of a lasting place.
