

FOXHUNTER A TRIBUTE.

The one and only Foxhunter has made his last jump. His famous partnership with Colonel Harry Llewellyn is ended. The great-hearted horse died, at 19, at the Colonel's home near Abergavenny. Stamina, courage, style, these were qualities which made Foxhunter unique.

In 1952, Foxhunter was flown to Helsinki, to jump at the Olympic Games. He was at the peak of his show-jumping ability; and that bare statement, applied to Foxhunter, is the highest possible praise. And there in Finland, Llewellyn in the saddle, he was superb and supreme. On that occasion they won Britain's only Gold Medal. In the hearts of millions whom he interested in Show Jumping the memory of Foxhunter is ensured of a lasting place.
