Many thanks for your letter of the 14th October relative to my letter to Mr. Darvas of the Ghana Film Unit concerning the Duke of Edinburgh's visit to Ghana in November in which we agreed to pay 10/- per foot used in our newsreel.

I am happy to note that you do not think it necessary to enter into a Library Royalty Agreement as should this material again be used on some future occasion I think it is an advantage to Ghana and I do not think we should be asked to pay for the material again.

As you know, we are distributing newsreels in about 90 countries and the more Ghana material is seen on the world's screens, the better it is for Ghana.

I will get in touch with Mr. Darvas at Merlin Films Limited regarding our requirements of a fine grain of this material. I think I should advise you that I would be willing to pay for a fine grain coverage of everything this is shot by the Ghana Film Unit during the Duke's forthcoming visit.
