U.S. CATHOLICS BIGGEST CHURCH

There's a new landmark in the American Capital, the largest
Roman Catholic church in the whole country. The dome is 200 feet high,
the spire more than 300. The edifice is called the "Maticual Shrine
of the Immoulate Compeptuon". Pive Cardibals attended the dedication
coremony, as well as every other important Catholic prelate in the
United States. It was indeed a great day for the Church. Planned
on the scale of a cathodral, the building has already cost 30-million
dellars and the walls inside have yet to be lined with marble, eleven
chapels and many alters yet to be finished.

Cardinal Spellman, Archhishep of New York, blessed the Church.

39 years have passed since the foundation stone was laid. Now, seventh largest church in the world, the vast building stands as a monument to the faith.
