Third: Zardin/Albert (Italy - 5:18,94)
Fourth: Benham/Pandolph (USA - 5:19,0)

It was a hair-raising all-out race on the 1,700 metres Olympia track.

ITALIAN BOBSLED CHAMPIONS

Italy's defending two-man bobaled champions flashed down Cortina's dangerous mile-leng ice slide in near record times in this two-day competition to all but clinch their fourth world championship.

Briver Eugenio Monti and his brakesman Renso Alvera had streaked Saturday twice down the E twisting slide in times of one manute 18,64 seconds and

1:19,05 - for a two-run total of 2:37,64.

Monti and Alvera were out for an unrecedented fourth consecutive championship. That was reached yesterday with the final two runs. This is the final classification:
